10:00 am, rain or shine



Note to photographers and camera people: The photo shoot will take place in a sheltered pocket beach. As Wreck Beach has no buildings in the distance visible from the Trail 6 Beach, please take photos and video where the background skyline is reminiscent of Wreck Beach.

The Bare Buns Run is an officially timed 5 kilometer run and walk on world renowned Wreck Beach. Hundreds of runners will be participating. On race day, onsite registration and check-in starts 9:00 a.m. at the foot of Wreck Beach Trail 6, with start time yet to be announced. The 2016 event features body painting and awards for every age category and finisher. Registration fees are \$25 adult, \$20 for youth 16 and under or seniors over 60, and includes a commemorative T-shirt or tank top. Teams are also welcome! Upon registration, the team name and captain must be noted. Proceeds go toward the Wreck Beach Preservation Society whose mandate is to preserve Wreck Beach in as nearly a natural state as possible.

Lifequards Needed at Wasaga Beach

On Sunday, August 23, a 23 year old woman died from drowning at Wasaga Beach, Canada's longest freshwater beach. Because there are no lifeguards, Tom McConkey, a member in good standing with the Federation of Canadian Naturists (FCN), was one of the first on the scene with his SeaDoo to aid in the rescue. The FCN agrees with Tom that signs advising parents to look after their children and life jackets blowing in the wind are inadequate measures to save lives.

Only 24 hours prior to aiding in the attempt to save this young woman, Tom approximately 20 other naturists participated in a naturist event organized by FCN Director, John Cropper. They had been told by the Ministry of Natural Resources (MNR) and the OPP that nudity is not permitted on Wasaga Beach. It turned out that the reprimand was without substance because only the Attorney General of each Province can prosecute for mere nudity. With only one complainant out of thousands of beach visitors about the small group of naturists at the secluded end of Beach Area 1, the officials left without incident. As a matter of fact, many sunbathers later doffed their clothes by the end of the day to join the naturists in a spontaneous nude-in! The Attorney General of each province is the only one who can decide if public social nudity will be prosecuted or not

In the meanwhile, the Federation calls for the immediate hiring of lifeguards and the installation of a lifeguard tower on the beach so that tragedies of the nature of Sunday, August 23rd do not happen again.


